

Changelog – August 2018

Release notes

- Downhole Survey API has been implemented.
- Structural API has been implemented.
- SPRINT-IQ approve screen has been added and users can now approve and reject survey runs.
- New Superseded status has been added for SPRINT-IQ runs instead of automatically rejecting data.
- XYZ coordinates for SPRINT-IQ are now calculated correctly for both in and out runs. Previously only the out run would be calculated.
- SPRINT-IQ options have been updated in View data to reflect new changes eg. Superseded.
- SPRINT-IQ has been added to the dashboard and can be toggled on/off via the account management section.
- SPRINT-IQ survey runs can be filtered in View data
- Users can now use the project name filter in the first Approve Surveys screen.
- Adindan grid zone 30N can now be used properly and no longer results in an error.
- Users can now reject unwanted TN14 surveys before assigning them.
- Users can now create API Keys under account management and use these to authenticate against IMDEXHUB-IQ APIs.
- You can now select/deselect any row in a grid by clicking on it.
- There should be less wait time when polling data from the survey API.
- There is now a warning when deleting an API key
- In Approve Surveys Group, Program and Tenement columns have been added and are able to be filtered
